#### The Birthstones for December are:

Tanzanite, Turquoise and Zircon all of which have a blue, green and purple tones. Keeping with the color scheme of the green, we have decided to focus on Moss Agate as this is one of the stones that we will find in our new club claim.

**Moss Agate** is a colorless, translucent, dendritic variety of Quartz. It has tree or fern like inclusions. Recent studies have shown that it is a mixture of Fibrous cryptocrystalline quartz and moganite.

Dendritic: Dendritic Agate is Chalcedony

Chalcedony: A variety of Quartz

Moganite: A silica mineral that is related to quartz but with a

different crystal structure

Inclustion: A solid, liquid, or gaseous foreign body enclosed in a mineral or rock.

Fibrous cryptocrystalline quartz: The term is often used for white, cloudy, or lightly colored material intergrown with moganite.
